
WHAT'S NEXT


#1 **SUBMIT**
You just submitted your completed FAFSA.

#2  = 
In 3-5 days, your FAFSA will process and you will receive a student aid report (SAR) via email.
* 7-10 days via mail if no working email is provided *

#3  
If your FAFSA has no errors, an Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) will appear on your SAR.
*If your FAFSA has errors that need to be corrected, your SAR will indicate how to correct your FAFSA. Once corrected, you will see your EFC.

#4 
24 hours after processing, the schools you listed will have access to your SAR.
*Depending on how quickly your school's process is, they may not retrieve your information immediately.

#5 
The schools will use your EFC to determine the amount of grants & other aid you're eligible for.
*This includes work study, state grants and additional loans and varies by state. Additionally, you will find out from your state if you are eligible for more aid to be included.

#6 
The schools will then send you a financial aid award letter, detailing the aid they will offer you.
